Terrorists attack

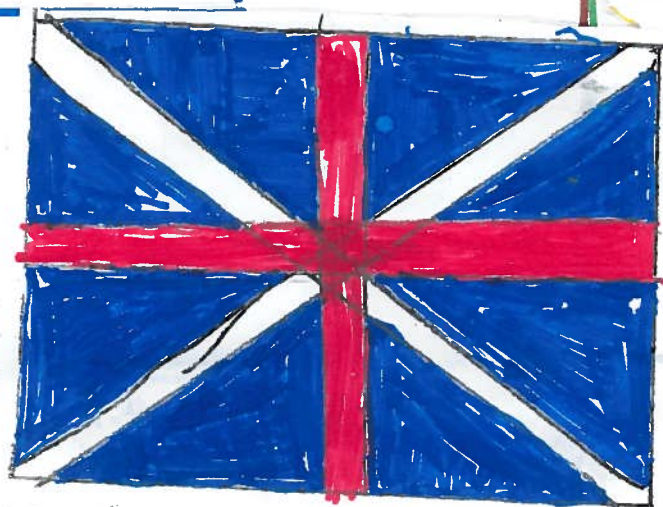
